The Formation of Regional Governments in Spain After the Elections of May 2019

In May 2019 elections were held in thirteen Regions or Autonomous Communities. In some of those regions results did not grant a parliamentary majority for any political party which led to the formation of coalition governments. Coalitions were too heterogenous and this phenomenon has been referred to as the "variable geometry" of regional governments.

In this paper results of this coalitions as well as the composition of these regional governments will be thoroughly assessed and explained.
